- To construct any buildings on any land or improve after or repair any building which may be acquired in the name of the society by purchase, gift, by grant of lease deed to further the objects of the trust.
- To open the engineering college education college, Law college, dental college, medical college c. or any type of education institution and get it affiliated from university, take NOC from any state central government or any government body.
- 17) To start, establish, run take over or manage and maintain schools, with an object to provide sound preprimary secondary, senior secondary and higher education to children by seeking recognition and affiliated from the education departments and concerned Govt. Authorities.
- To do best efforts for the promotion of medical education and by running various schools, college and other medical research centers, after getting the approval from the competent authority.
- To promote literacy, culture and other social activities by Awareness Programs, Adult Education Classes, Lecturers, Essay competitions, Exhibitions, Symposiums, Cultural Programs, Press Conferences and Seminars in the minority's community.
- 20 To engage, employ or hire appropriate staff, workers, legal experts and other professionals, attorneys, manager and agents for the work and furtherance of the aims and objects of the society and to pay their wages, salaries, stipends or fees.
- 21 To receive financial and non-financial assistance from Govt. and Non Govt. Organizations.
- 22. To invest the money of the society not immediately required, in Mutual Funds. UTI Securities or Deposits as are permitted by the law for the time being in force.

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- Establishment or maintenance of libraries or reading rooms.
- 24 To raise or acquire funds or property from central government. State Government, Non-Government agencies, Charitable Trust by way of donations or grants or contribution or by taking loan from public and private financial institutions. The funds, properties assets and all other resources, present and future of the society shall be utilized for any or all the purpose or objects of the society as stated above and also for all other similar activities in furtherance for ideal of truth and non-violence.
- 25 The income and property of the society shall be applied solely towards promotion of the objects of the society and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred. directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus or distribution of any assets. income or profits to its members or their dependent or legal heirs.

ANCIALARY OBJECTS:

- The income and property of the society shall be applied society towards the promotion of the objects of the society estset forth in the Memorandum of Association and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly, to the members of the society.
- To acquire by purchase, take or decise are or by gift and hold any moveable В and immovable properties or any rights or privileges that may be deemed necessary or useful for the advancement of the objects of the society.
- No member of the Society shall be appointed to any salaried office of the C Society, or any office of the Society paid by fees that no remuneration shall be given by the society to any member of such society repayment of out of pocket expenses and interest on money lent or rent for premises/demises to the society.
- The Society by its constitution is required to apply its profits, if any, or other income D in promoting its objects.
- If upon the winding up or dissolution of the Society there remains after satisfaction E of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the society but shall be given or transferred to some other institution having objects similar to the objects of the society to be determined by the members of the Society at or before the time of dissolution.

3. Membership of Society:

> A person shall be eligible to become a member of Society, if he: a) Eligibility:

- Is 21 year of age on the date of admission? i)
- Subscribes to the aims and objects of the society. ii)
- Has deposited the membership fee. iii)
- Is not be and insolvent and of unsound mind or have not been iv) convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude, punishable with imprisonment of one year of more;

b) Type of Members:

Ordinary Member: : Sh. Dharam Singh S/o Stuag Ram

The Society shall have maximum total number of twenty ordinary members who shall continue to enjoy their membership only so long as they are not in arrears of payment of their annual subscription fees.

Admission Procedure (for members other than the subscribers):

- The admission of a person as a member of the society shall be decided by its governing body from time to time.
- An individual willing to be a member of the society has to submit an ii) application in prescribed form, and along with supporting documents to the Secretary duly filled in and signed and recommended by a regular member of the society.
- The Secretary shall examine the application and place the same before iii) the Governing Body for a decision.
- The Governing Body any accept or reject the application and the iv) decision of the Governing Body in this regard shall be final. It shall not be bound to assign any reason for its decision.
- The approval of the Governing Body shall be intimated to the member, his V) name shall be entered in the register of members, to be maintained in such manner & form as prescribed under the Haryana Societies Registration and Regulation Rules, 2012

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final decision in respect of his membership will be taken by the governing body on the basis of the facts given by him and decision of the governing body will be final.

In case the governing body is not satisfied his membership will be terminated immediately and the decision will be ratified by the general body later on. After approval of the General Body meeting his name will be struck off from the Register of membership and he will not be entitled to enjoy the rights of the membership.

Re-admission of expelled /suspended member:

The suspension of membership on account of default in payment of the

annual subscription may be revoked after he has cleared the default along with 18% interest on the amount payable with the majority decision of the Governing body. However, he shall not be eligible to cast his vote in any election held during the remainder of the financial year.

however if District Registrar, Registrar General give directions in writing to society for removal of a member ,who has been either convicted of an offence amounting to moral turpitude or any misconduct, may be removed from membership.

7. Rights & Duties of members:

(i) Every member shell subscribe to and be bound by the bylaws as amended from time and registered with the District Registrar.

elections of the society provided such member is not a defaulter in payment of any dues of the society and the annual subscription for a period of three months beyond the due date.

(iii) Every member of the society shall have the right to inspect the books of accounts books containing the minutes of proceedings of the general meeting, meeting of the governing body and register of member of the society on any working day giving a notice of seven days.

(iv) Every member shall inform the society about any change in his address in writing. Which shall be duly recorded in the register of members of the society and upon which the society shall issue a fresh identity card to such member.

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Membership Fee & Annual subscription;

- i) Admission fee Rs 1100/-
- ii) Annual Subscription Rs 500/-
- iii) The payment of membership fee shall be made by the applicant from his bank account through a bank Instrument (Demand draft/pay order/cheque) and in no case be accepted in cash.
- The payment annual subscription of a member shall become due as on the 1st of April of every year, which may be paid latest by the 30th of June of such year. The membership of a defaulting member shall be deemed to be under suspension after the due date (30th June) and such member shall not be entitled to cast his vote during the elections of the society held after 1st July of the said year.

procedure for withdrawal from Membership;

If a person willing to be member of the society submit the application in prescribed form alongwith supporting documents to the secretary duly filled in and signed and recommended by a regular member of the society can withdraw his/her membership application before placing the same in governing body.

Cessation of membership:

Upon his/her acting contrary to the aims and objectives of the society

Upon such member being found guilty of a financial misappropriation of the funds of the society.

Upon indictment and directions for removal by the District Registrar /Registrar General of Societies.

Procedure for termination from Membership:

If a regular member violate Clause 5 sub clause (i) to (vii) above, a notice will be served by registered post by the secretary regarding the violation of rules. Thus providing him an opportunity to explain his position personally in the governing body meeting and

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meeting shall not be less than a minimum of three. the general body shall be competent to transact all business in such adjourned meeting except the consideration of any special resolution. Any special resolution can be passed in such adjourned meeting only if at least three -fifth of the total members of the society are present.

vi) The proceedings of all meeting of the general body will be recorded in the minutes -book (bound or in loose leaves) maintained separately for the purpose by the secretary and such minutes will be signed by the president of the meeting and the secretary of the society.

However at least one meeting of the general body of the society, called as the Annual General Meeting (AGM) will be held in a year within six months of the close of the financial year consideration and adoption of the duly audited annual accounts of the society in addition to transaction of any other business of the aciety as may be required.

iii) Notwithstanding the restriction corescribed above a society may pay such remuneration salary or honorarium to be persons in the full time or part time employment as it may determine Provided that no medical state of the employment of the society.

27 Operation of Bank Accounts;

An account having cheque facility will be opened in any scheduled bank post office or any other private financial institution in the name of the society .All the transaction will be made under the Joint Signatures of any two i.e. president, Secretary, Treasurer.

28 Provisions relating to Audit of the society's accounts

The bye laws of a society should provide for audit of annual accounts of the society from an auditor who is a member of the institute of Chartered Accountants of India and such auditor should not be a member of the governing body of the society.

29 Amendments in the Memorandum, Bye-Laws, Name of the Society, etc.

Any amendment in the memorandum of Association and bye laws or change of name amalgamation or division of the society will be done only with the approved of the general body by way of a special resolution .The intimation of any such amendment or change alongwith attested copy of the requisite documents shall be filed in the office of the District Registrar by the secretary within such time as may be

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
